### 100MW PV system for the Vatican

300 kWh for 100 houses would be an average of 8.2 kWh/day. I use about 16 kWh/day and I don't use much electricity at all, so that doesn't make sense. But 300 kWp / 2400 panels is 125 Wp/panel; a reasonable Wp value for a typical normal size solar panel.

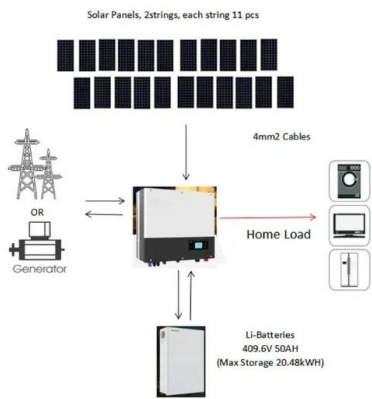
