Overview

Two people died, nine were injured and three were missing after an explosion on Monday at a fuel storage facility near Florence owned by Italian energy firm Eni, the president of the Tuscany region said. On April 30, 1946, the USS Solar, a U.S. Navy Buckley-class destroyer escort (DE 221), exploded at the Navy Pier in Leonardo, killing seven sailors and injuring 125 others. The Solar was refitted in 1946 to serve as a sonar test vessel. On April 30, she was berthed at Leonardo Pier I of Naval. 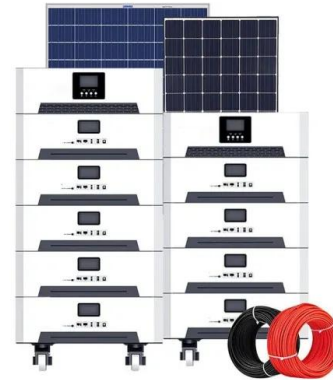

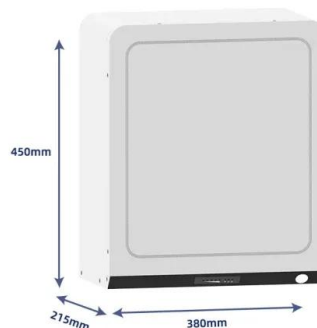
