Belize's Power Plug And Wattage Requirements

Belize uses three types of power plugs: A, B, and G. The standard voltage is 110V or 220V, and the frequency is 60Hz. If you are travelling to Belize from the US, you will need a power plug adapter for sockets type A and G. However, sockets type B can fit your plugs, but may not always be available locally.

Belize's Electrical System: Compatibility With Us Standards

Belize's electricity is the same as in the US in terms of voltage and frequency. However, there are some differences in power outlets/plugs. While the primary power supply in Belize is the Type G outlet, which requires a power adapter for US plugs, Type A and Type B outlets, which are the same as in the US, are also used in Belize.

U.S. to Belize Power Adapter: What Plug Do I Need? (2024)

Belize is unusual in that it has multiple voltage types depending on the region or city. The power supply is inconsistent throughout the country and some locations run power at 220V, while others run it at 110V. Belize has three compatible plug types - A, B, and G:

Juice in Belize is nominally the same as the USA (120V, 60hz) and uses the same connectors, but substandard electrical instalations abound and low voltage is common. It is also common for outlets to not have a ground pin and if they do it is almost certainly not wired properly.
