Bolivia and China Sign US\$1 Billion Contract for Lithium Extraction

Bolivia and China have signed an agreement for the extraction of lithium from the South American country. The service contract, worth US\$1.03 billion, will enable the development of the final engineering design, construction and operation of a plant that will produce 10,000 tons of battery-grade lithium carbonate per year.

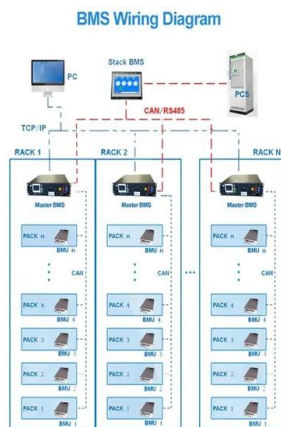


BOLIVIA: Charging up for lithium battery demand infographic

Enticed by lithium prices more than doubling in recent years, as demand for electric vehicles and



smart devices (powered by lithium-ion batteries) escalates, Bolivia sees an opportunity to get in on the action. However, this year has seen prices tumble to around \$10 per kilogram as countries such as Chile and China ramp up mining production.

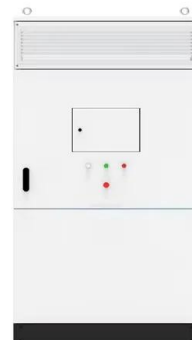


China and Bolivia sign \$1bn deal to build two production plants ...

The recent \$1bn deal with Chinese consortium CBC will see two direct lithium extraction plants built in the Uyuni salt flat. Lithium battery producer CATL is a subsidiary of CBC. The Bolivian government will take a 51% stake in the project, with YLB revealing that the two plants together are intended to produce 35,000 tons of lithium a year.

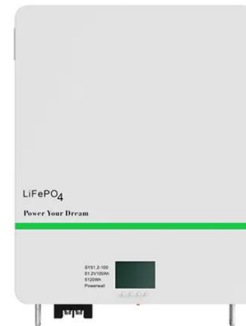
