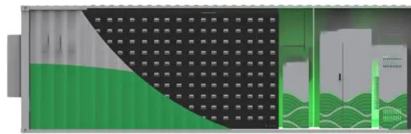


Design, Economic, and Environmental Analysis of a Stand-Alone Solar ...

Abstract: Access to affordable and reliable energy in rural parts of Burundi can significantly improve its socio-economic development and contribute to the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions. Stand-alone solar photovoltaic (PV) systems are a safe, efficient, and environmentally friendly solution for providing energy to underserved regions.

Grid-connected solar PV project , Mubuga, Burundi

REPP's investment in Mubuga supports Burundi's Updated NDC (2021) conditional target to reduce GHG emissions by 23% by 2030. The project is identified as a priority project to help Burundi meet its unconditional 3% GHG emissions reduction target.

London, 23 January 2020: Gigawatt Global's 7.5MW solar plant in Burundi is to become the first grid-connected project supported by the Renewable Energy Performance Platform (REPP) to begin full construction. The project is also the first grid-connected solar development by an independent power producer (IPP) in Burundi.

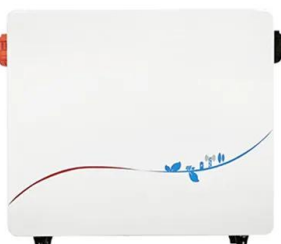

Burundi's First Utility-Scale Solar Plant Expands Africa's ...

Built through a multinational effort, the pioneering 7.5 MW solar PV plant near the village of Mubuga has been in operation since May 2021 and now provides over 10% of Burundi's electricity, supplying clean power to tens of thousands of homes and businesses.



Burundi Inaugurates Country's First Utility-scale Solar Power Field

The multinational effort was Burundi's first substantial energy generation project in over three decades, and the 7.5-megawatt solar field is the country's first utility-scale solar power station.

This pioneering solar project, proudly supported through UK international climate finance, has increased Burundi's generation capacity by over 10% and is helping propel the country towards a cleaner and more sustainable energy future."



First solar field in Burundi lights up tens of thousands of homes

The pioneering 7.5MW solar PV plant has increased Burundi's generation capacity by over 10% and is the country's first substantial energy generation project to go online in over three decades, supplying clean power to tens of thousands of homes and businesses - just before the start of COP26.
