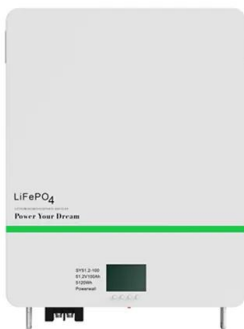

token fee. We use our own concrete poles produced in Chad to build the grid network.

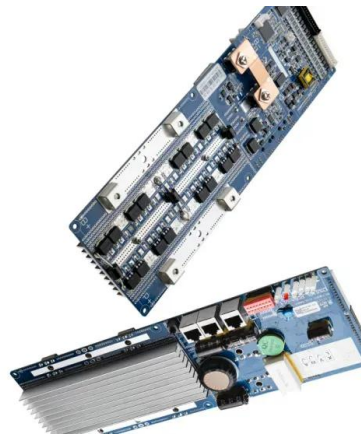
