

Chronograph power reserve time





Overview

The power reserve is the time it takes for the fully charged energy store to completely release its energy, without being supplied with new energy in the meantime. In other words, the power reserve is the time from when the mainspring is fully wound to the moment the watch stops. Power Reserve refers to the running time of a fully wound mechanical watch (manual-wind or automatic). For example, if you fully wind your watch and place it on your dresser, how long before it stops running and needs to be wound again – that is the power reserve. This is determined by the amount.
