inaugurated by President Faustin Archange Touadera on 17 November 2023, covers a 70-hectare site in the village of Danzi, 20 km north of Bangui, the capital of CAR.

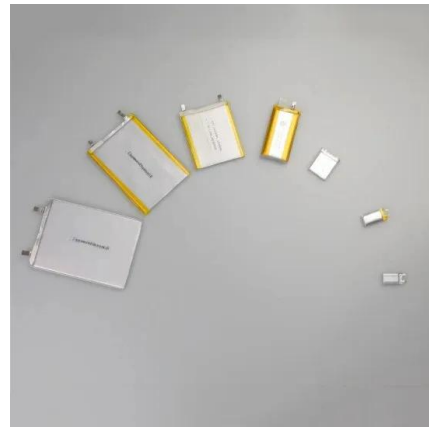

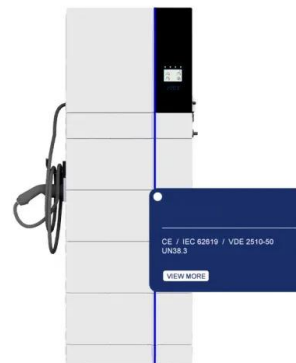
