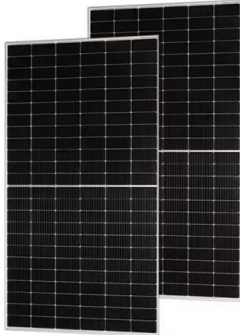

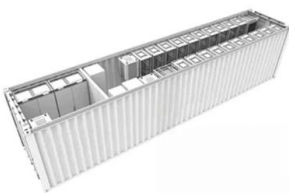

Electricity in Faroe Islands - voltage and frequency. All power sockets in Faroe Islands provide a standard voltage of 230V with a standard frequency of 50Hz. You can use all your equipment in Faroe Islands if the outlet voltage in your own country is between 220V-240V.

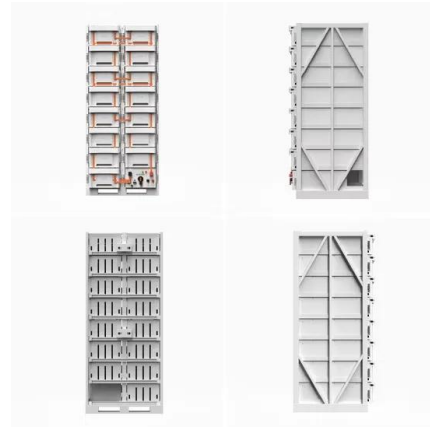

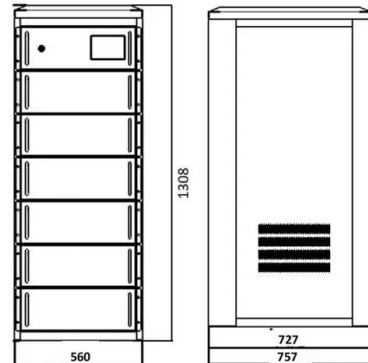
