## Overview

---

In 2022, solar power accounted for 12.6% of total electricity generation in Greece, up from 0.3% in 2010 and less than 0.1% in 2000. [3] The national government's 2023 National Energy & Climate Plan anticipates solar PV capacity rising from 4.8 GW in 2022 to 14.1 GW in 2030, and 34.5 GW in 2050.

Solar power in Greece has been driven by a combination of government incentives and equipment cost reductions. The installation boom started in the late 2000s with feed-in tariffs has evolved into a market featuring.

With a budget of EUR 200 million (USD 217.5m), the programme will enable households and farmers to install up to 10.8 kW of PV capacity and 10.8 kWh of battery storage, Energy Minister Kostas Skrekas announced.



### Greece and its solar power system: an overview

The development of solar power in Greece started in 2006 but peaked only in 2009 and, as of December 2013, the total installed photovoltaic capacity in Greece reached 2,419.2 MWp. In April 2022, the Greek Prime Minister, Kyriakos Mitsotakis, inaugurated a new solar park in Kozani, the country's Western Macedonia region.

According to a new report by industry association Solar Power Europe, Greece's total installed capacity last year grew by 20% with 1.6 Gigawatt of installed capacity added. By the end of the decade total installed capacity could more than triple to 29.6 GW, the report added, faster than projected under the Greek government's national energy

Energy Minister Kostas Skrekas said that Greece took first place among European countries last year in the participation of solar power in its total energy mix. In 2022, Greece saw record activity in the market for photovoltaics, according to Solar Power Europe in its latest EU outlook.
