The average annual precipitation amounts to about 2000 mm (78.7 inches) and receives 242 rainy days on the 1 mm (0.04 inches). A common trait of the city's climate is the predominantly high temperatures, with monthly averages falling within the range from 29.8°C (85.6°F) to 31.8°C (89.2°F) for the high temperatures and from 24.7°C (76.5°F) to 26.5°C (79.7°F) for the low temperatures. 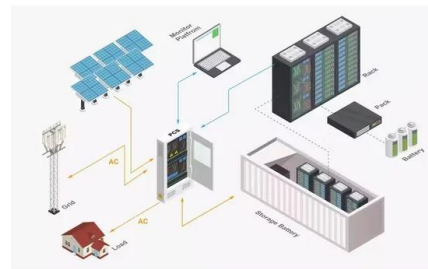
