Energy is essential for our daily living and social activities. However, Japan is a country with a low energy self-sufficiency ratio, with a percentage of 12.1% in FY2019, a considerably low level compared with other OECD countries. It was 20.2% in FY2010 before the Great East Japan Earthquake.

1 · The Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry (METI) has presented a draft of a new basic energy plan to a panel of experts for review. Designed to guide Japan's medium- to long-term energy policy, it clearly includes nuclear power deed, it states that nuclear energy should be utilized to the maximum extent possible.. Japan's basic energy plan is revised every three years.

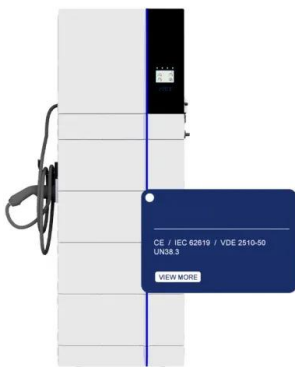


Proposed 2040 energy targets: 20% nuclear, 40-50% renewables

The industry ministry is making final tweaks to set Japan's energy reliance in fiscal 2040 to nuclear power at 20 percent and renewable energy, such as solar and wind, to rise to 40 to 50 percent.

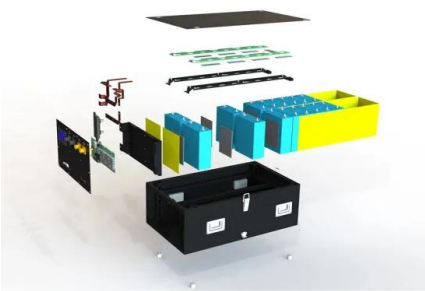
