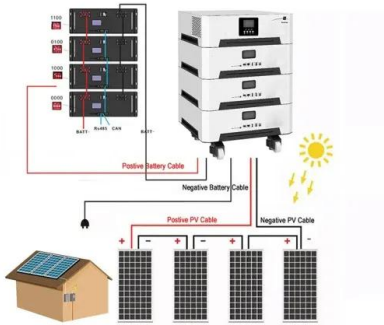

To encourage investment into hydropower infrastructure, the government exempts renewable energy companies from VAT when importing equipment and offers power purchasing agreements for electricity
