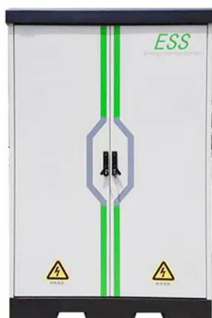

Tonga depends on imported diesel for over 75% of its electricity needs, and the high cost imposes a heavy burden on consumers and underpins the economic growth.

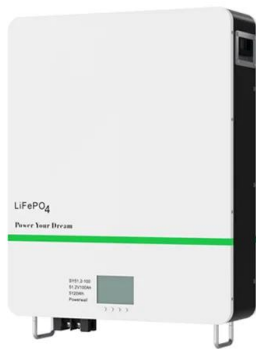

Akuo bags 6-MW battery storage project in Tonga

French renewable power producer Akuo Energy said Friday it has secured a contract to build in Tonga an energy storage system with a capacity of 23.4 MWh/6 MW. The company will be in charge of the engineering, procurement and construction (EPC) of the Tonga 2 facility under a contract signed in November with grid operator Tonga Power Ltd.

2. The facility will finance the grants to the Kingdom of Tonga for the Renewable Energy Project (REP). The REP will help Tonga rapidly move from its heavy dependence on imported fossil fuels for power generation (about 90%) to using clean and renewable energy resources that are low carbon and climate resilient.

The two battery storage facilities installed in Tonga are complementary: the aim of the first 5 MWh / 10 MW battery is to improve the electricity grid's stability (regulating the voltage and frequency), while the second 23 MWh / 7 MW battery is designed to transfer the electrical load



in order to help the grid supply electricity at peak times



Tiny Tonga uses big batteries to reach ambitious renewable energy

The tiny Kingdom of Tonga is using large scale batteries to help it reach a renewable energy target (RET) of 50 per cent by 2020 - and ditch its reliance on diesel generators. The South Pacific island group is boosting renewable capacity by adding the Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) to its Popua Power Station.
