North Macedonia's government said it has selected Bulgarian solar energy equipment supplier Solarpro Holding [BUL:058] and Turkish Fortim Energy Electric to build photovoltaic power plants of combined 100 MW at the location of an old mine in Oslomej.

North Macedonia's power utility ESM aims to build 1 GW of solar

The North Macedonian state-owned power utility ESM plans to build 1 GW of solar PV capacity either through direct investments or public-private partnerships (PPPs). The company aims to shift its power generation to renewables. The installed power capacity of North Macedonia reached 1.9 GW at the end of 2020.



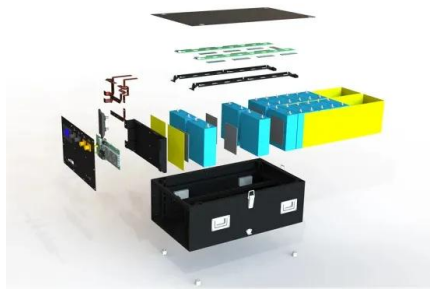
North Macedonia fast-tracks two solar power plant projects of 155 MW ...

Shortly after Akuo Energy's photovoltaic project of up to 400 MW in Stip was declared a strategic investment, the Government of North Macedonia gave the same status to two planned solar power plants in Pehcevo and Karbinci in the country's east. Renewable Power International will invest in a photovoltaic power plant with a capacity of 85 MW.
