The fast-acting BESS will help provide grid stability and integrate more renewable resources on Ireland's electricity system, ESB said on Friday, 15 July.

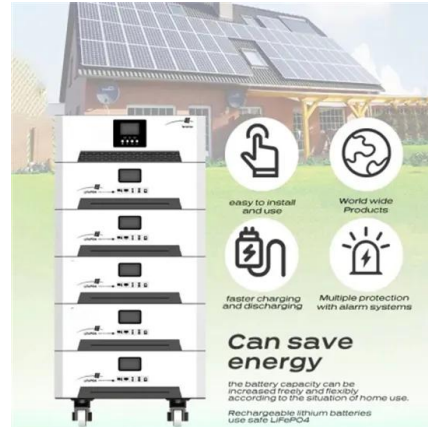

ESB has five BESS projects in total. Aghada I (19MW), Kylemore (30MW), Poolbeg (75MW) and South Wall (30MW) are all operational with Aghada II (150MW) on schedule to be commercially available in 2024. We expect to have over 300MWs of battery capacity, making it the largest battery portfolio in Europe.
