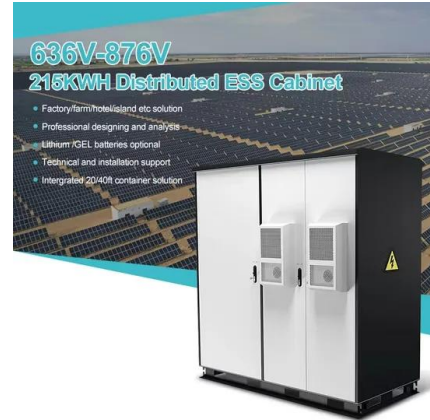

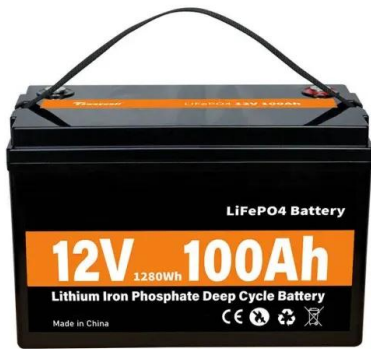


Convalt Energy commits to community solar plants in Chad
