Electricity and Home Appliances in Thailand

Domestic power in Thailand is 220 volts AC at 50 hertz (220V/50Hz). All electrical and electronic equipment designed for use in the UK or EU should work in Thailand, although it may be necessary to change the plug, or use a travel adapter.

Some electrical connections in Thailand may not be safe, so always exercise caution. Thailand's electrical grid is stable in city areas but may not be stable in rural areas. You can buy 220 volt to 120 volt converters at HomePro and Saphan Lek.

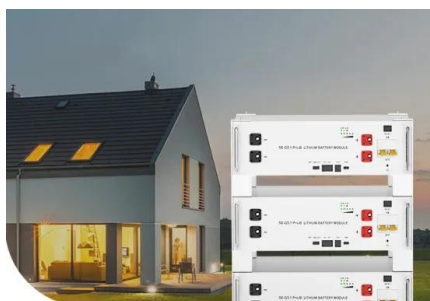

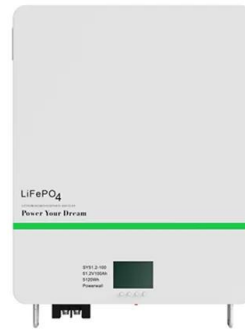
