Located in central Togo, this 50 megawatt facility will provide power to more than 158,000 households and save more than one million tonnes of CO2 emissions. The plant was built by AMEA Togo

The funding has been allocated as part of the Regional Solar Emergency Response Project (RESPITE), for which the World Bank has released \$311 million in 2023, and which will be deployed in four sub-Saharan African countries. In addition to Togo, the World Bank's Respite programme is being implemented in Liberia, Sierra Leone and Chad.



Togo Secures Solar Energy Deals with RELP and Chinese HAIER

The first agreement with RELP focuses on enhancing Togo's solar energy storage capacity. This will improve the Battery Energy Storage System, allowing excess energy produced during the day to be stored for nighttime use, according to Minister Robert Eklo.

World Bank Signs \$64.2 Million Funding Agreement with Togo for Solar ...



The World Bank and Togo have signed a \$64.2 million financing agreement as part of the Regional Solar Emergency Response Project (RESPITE) to electrify at least 60 localities via renewable electricity. The project includes a 25 MWp solar plant with battery storage and will provide electricity for 12,100 rural households and public lighting.



Adétikopé Solar Power Station

The Adétikopé Solar Power Station is a planned 390 MW (520,000 hp) solar power plant in Togo, with 200 MWh (720 GJ), attached battery energy storage. The power station is in the development stage, under concessional terms by the company Arise Integrated Industrial Platforms (Arise IIP), a subsidiary of the Africa Finance Corporation (AFC
